Holiday Recipies

Mi-Mor's Molasses Cookies

Ingredients:

- ³/₄ c vegi oil
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1/3 cup molasses
- 1 egg beaten
- 2 tsp baking soda
- 2 cups flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. each salt, cloves, ginger
- 1 tsp. heaping cinnamon

Directions

- 1. Beat oil, sugar, molasses egg
- 2. Add flour, baking soda, salt, cloves, ginger, cinnamon
- 3. Roll into balls dip into sugar
- 4. Bake 350 degrees 8-10 mins till cookies crack
- 5. Don't over cook

Mor-Mor Nelson's Pepparkakor

Ingredients: 1 cup shortening 1 cup sugar 1 cup molasses (light Brer Rabbit) 1 egg well beaten 1 tsp. baking soda 1 tsp. cloves 1 tsp. ginger 1 tsp. nutmeg 1 tsp. cinnamon 4 cups flour



- 1. Boil the shortening, sugar and molasses. Let cool.
- 2. Mix with the rest of the ingredients
- 3. Let set overnight
- 4. Roll out and cut with your favorite cookie cutters!
- 5. Add some sprinkles if you're feeling fancy
- 6. Bake at 350 degrees for 10 minutes





Ramona Talbot's Spritz

Ingredients

1 lb butter room temp. 1 ½ cup sugar 3 egg yokes 4 cups flour 2 tbsp almond extract

Directions:

Mix together all ingredients
Put the dough into a cookie press

- 3. Place the cookies onto a cookie sheet
- 4. Bake at 375 degrees for 8–10 mins




